It is our great honor and pleasure that Mr. President have taken your time out of your busy schedule to deliver a keynote address as well as officially inaugurate "the First Business Summit 2017". It is also our great honor to have His Excellency President of South Africa on this occasion.

Mr. President, Distinguished ladies and gentlemen,

Representing the Ministry of Trade and the committee, I would like to extend our warm greetings and welcome to Indonesia to all Ministers, Members of the IORA Chambers of Commerce and Industry, CEOs, business leaders and government officials. IORA Business Summit will address specific issues that have become the center of attention for us and the global community, including issues of SMEs empowerment and globalization; women empowerment through innovation, digitization and access to finance; tourism; connectivity; and infrastructure.

The essence of this Summit is an opportunity to take note to the advice and views directly from the Heads of State/Governments of the IORA key states regarding the best measures to promote a just and sustainable growth in the Indian Ocean Region.

The issues to be raised are not novel, instead, it may sound "outdated". However, it is exactly what we are currently facing, it is how globalization can go simultaneously, reinforce each other, within the principle of promoting a just and sustainable economic growth.

The Summit has been preceded by a small meeting attended by representatives of the IORA Chambers of Commerce and Industry. The objective was to prepare the draft of Joint Declaration of IORA Business Community in Promoteing a just and sustainable economic growth. The elements of the Joint Declaration would be discussed and finalized later this afternoon, to be reported to IORA Leaders tomorrow, March 7, 2017.

Mr. President and Ladies and Gentlemen,

To conclude, the IORA business community--represented by its respective Chamber of Commerce and Industry--has come together, taken the leadership process, and agreed to work closely with the IORA governments to build a better future of this vast region.

Today, a history has been written. Today we can all say that in commemorating the 20th Anniversary of the IORA, the governments and the businesses have pledged to strengthen cooperation, to realize our shared dreams.

Finally, we invite His Excellency President Joko Widodo to deliver the Keynote speech, as well as officially inaugurate the first IORA Business Summit. Thank you.
